- 1a. Is there an answer in the Bible for every Christian spiritual question?b. If "yes" is answer to question (1), then should we search in another book (that is not Bible) for answer to Christian spiritual question?c. If "no" is answer to question (1), then what are those Christian spiritual questions that are not answered by the Bible?
- 2. Kindly throw more light on \*1 John 4:17\* "Herein is our love made perfect, that we may have boldness in the day of judgment: because as he is, so are we in this world" how can we attain to the level of "as he is" are we already "as he is" if so why are still many things hanging around our life that we know is not as he is.
